Each middle school student is required to obtain service hours during the school year. Students may start their service projects in the summer and must have the hours completed by May 1, 2024. If you do this with an open heart and bring the truth of the gospels with you then you leave Jesus Christ with everyone you meet. You should try to serve others in the community, in your church, and in your family.

Examples of Christian Service Projects:

- Volunteer your services at school
Campus clean-up
Enrichment class teacher assistant on Wednesday afternoons 1:50 – 3:00 (must be approved)
- Collect travel size toiletries for blessing bags put together at school
- Organize a collection in your neighborhood for Catholic Charities
- Participate or initiate environmental programs in your school or neighborhood
- Visit an elderly home
- Help a younger student with homework in extended care (must be approved/supervised)
- Volunteer to baby-sit *outside* your family for free
- Volunteer in the summer for Vacation Bible School or other camps

Mandatory Minimums for each grade:

- Grade 6 = 5 hours
- Grade 7 = 10 hours
- Grade 8 = 20 hours
