SCHOOL PLANS FOR RE-OPENING

The San Jose Catholic Church & School administration is working hard to develop a re-entry plan that allows for flexibility and transparency while prioritizing the health and safety of our community. We are currently preparing the campus to open the school year with students in August based on local, state, and federal guidelines and recommendations.

In this document, you will find information regarding our Return to School Plan (RTS) that will be referred to throughout the 2020-2021 school year. In the coming weeks, we will be publishing additional details and updates to this document as we finalize plans regarding on-campus modifications. We anticipate starting the school year in Level 2 of the On-Campus Operations Plan. We also plan to provide an Innovative Learning Opportunity, with the approval of the Florida Department of Education, for families that choose to opt for distance learning.

Our leadership team is preparing for possible waves of interruption to on-campus learning in the event of a government-ordered closure or to complete necessary cleaning due to a positive case on campus. If an interruption of physical operations occurs, a shift to distance learning will occur immediately.

classes and after school.



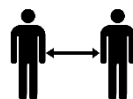
Athletics governed by

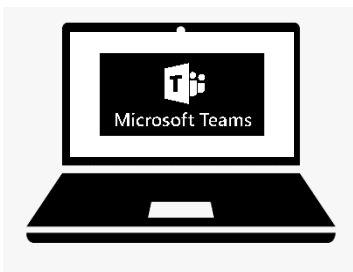
Opting for distance learning will include the commitment for the duration of each quarter.

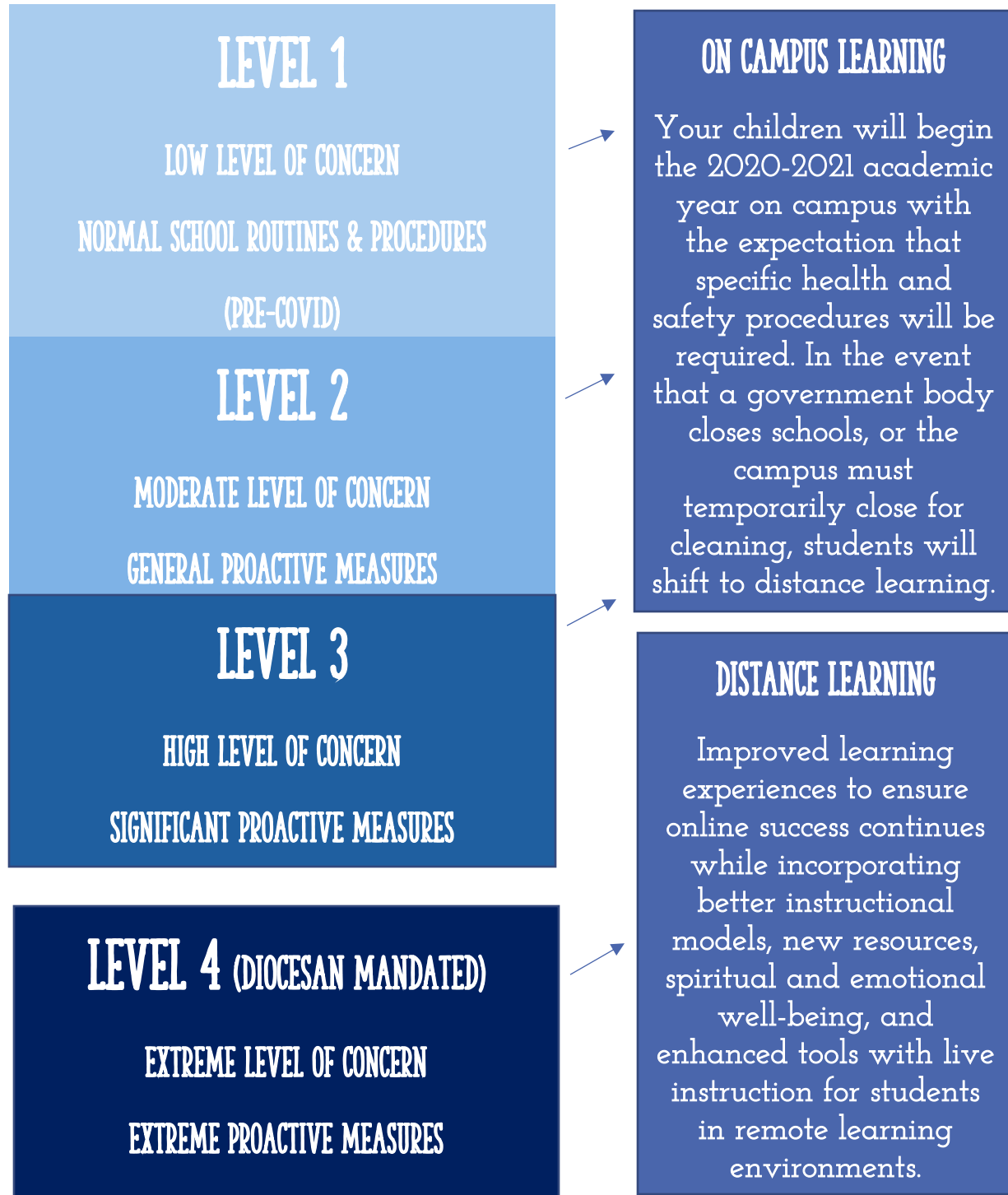

The Covid-Operations Plan has four levels. Each level increases concern and has students learning on campus or through distance learning. Review the following levels:

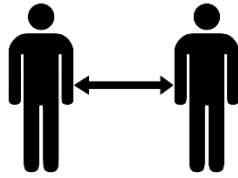


PROTECTION
