Subject: 20-21 Academic Year Update

Good morning San Jose Families.

It's hard to believe that our summer is more than halfway over. We know that our 20-21 school year will look different; however, the San Jose Catholic Church & School administration is working hard to develop a re-entry plan that allows for flexibility and transparency while prioritizing the health and safety of our community. We are currently preparing the campus to open the school year with students in August based on local, state, and federal guidelines and recommendations.

I know that many families have been anxiously awaiting our plan on returning to school in August. Attached you will find a Return to School Parent Guide. This guide is to serve as a tool to answer some overall questions. A more detailed plan will be released in the coming weeks with information regarding arrival and dismissal procedures, and other pertinent information for our return to school on August 10th.

In addition to having the option to attend school on campus, the Florida Department of Education granted an Executive Order that we may now offer Distance Learning to our families. It will not look like Distance Learning did in the Spring. The instruction provided through Distance Learning will be live and follow regularly scheduled school hours.
