Dear Families,

San Jose Catholic School reported to the Office of the Superintendent that one employee has tested positive for COVID-19. Due to the privacy laws that exist, we are unable to name the individual in this letter. The administration quickly reported the case to our office to document and begin our action steps at the diocese and the school.

The school took immediate action to sanitize all spaces used by the employee, which they have been doing regularly as part of their standard operating procedures, but also in light of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Our office contacted the Florida Department of Health (FLDOH) to make sure that we were taking all appropriate actions to contain the situation. The employee will be isolated at home and may not return to campus for ten days or until he/she is 72 hours fever-free with no fever-reducing medication, whichever is longer. Members of the school community who were in close contact, by definition from the FLDOH; therefore, they will be quarantined for 14 days. All parties have been notified. No further action is necessary at this time.

I would like to applaud the actions of the school's principal, Mrs. Jennifer Studer, and staff for their immediate action.

If any member of San Jose Catholic School who displays any symptoms, he or she should not come to school and should notify the school immediately.

Let us pray for all those who have contracted COVID-19 and for all their families as they work to restore their good health.
