GENERAL RULE OF LAW GOVERNING RAFFLES - It is important to keep in mind that raffles are illegal, except as to charitable organizations (and some lotteries). Florida law makes it unlawful for any person in this state to "conduct any lottery for money, or for anything of value... conduct any lottery drawing... for the distribution of a prize for lot of chance..." (emphasis added). The law prohibits a broad range of raffles that are related to any lottery or drawing for chance. A person guilty of violating these provisions is guilty of a felony in the third degree. An exception is given to a charitable organization with restrictions. These restrictions are detailed here: But the most important restriction is the prohibition of any payment or contribution for participating in a charity raffle. There are 2 elements for a raffle to be illegal even when conducted for a charity: 1.) Giving a prize (money or anything of value) and 2.) Drawing the winner by chance (or a similar method). And 3.) Drawing a purchaser or contributor before offering a person an opportunity to win the prize. (Keep in mind that above 3 elements is required. The charity may conduct the raffle if 2 when these three elements appear together that the law is violated. No purchase or contribution is necessary. 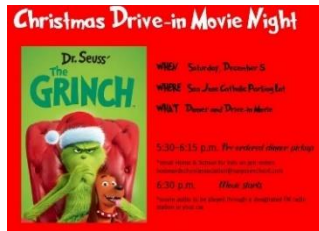
